## **Meet Reports**

**Newlands Caravan Site, Stratford upon Avon**

**Thursday 15.7.10 – Sunday 18.7.10**

Attending: George Dom and Kevin, Mike and Wayne with Chico and Ted (dogs), David, John and Patch the dog

Arrived on site Thursday lunchtime after a leisurely drive from Mansfield, only to be greeted by a site entrance with caravans parked close to each other, which immediately rung alarm bells that we would not be able to manoeuvre on site, this was quickly quashed as we were to pitch in a large field at the back of the site which was very easy for parking. John and patch arrived around 3pm and pitched up next to our van.

When we had both settled in, Patch needed a walk, so off we went on one of Johns 10 minute walks across the fields to Loxley, a small village about a mile away. We followed the yellow footpath signs, ducked when the trainer planes took off from the nearby airfield, and finally arrived in Loxley about half an hour later- nowt there but a pretty village. After catching our second wind, it was off back on another footpath back to site. The problem we had was the signs ran out, and we came up against a field of sheep and two fences to jump over with no foot stile. Over we went, and then off on the path back to site, arriving another half hour later. Not bad for 10 minutes, but a nice walk. That evening, we sat in our van, drinking and catching up on the news.

Friday, a nice morning, we were about to go touring but John took patch out for another 10 minute- 1 hour walk, so we went off to Hatton Park. A small collection of shops, everything from sweets, cafe, antiques, garden centre and a kid's adventure playground. It filled in two hours, and then it was back to site for a quick sandwich, collect John, and off to Warwick Castle the four of us went. £4 to park, and £17.95 each to get in, but John was to vein to admit he qualified for being 55 and could receive a concession admission price of £13.75. The castle and grounds were packed with foreign tourists all queuing for the various attractions, so we walked around the outside of the castle first, then visited the hot house to see the indoor plants, before going to watch the owl and vulture display in the grounds which were interrupted by a light shower of rain. Off we then went to see inside the castle. First stop was the tea room, where we all had coffee and scones, which were more like medieval rock buns, but they satisfied a need. We then started the tour of the castle, through the main hall where we saw the campest of servants mincing around. He wore knickerbockers, pointy shoes, a light green velvet coat, frilly shirt and blonde long curly wig, and by god did he love himself, mincing through the halls- natural or put on? Natural! Tourists thought him a laugh. We then walked through the castle state rooms, kitchen, and exhibitions, before winding our way up the very narrow staircase around the towers to the castle walls. Very steep, but the views! Time was getting on, so around 4.30pm, we headed back to site to await the arrival of Dave, all the way from

Coventry – 23 miles away, and Mike and Wayne from Chesterfield. By 6.30pm, all had arrived, and that evening was spent in our van getting to know each other and discussing the FCC.

Saturday, and the airfield next to the site had a market which started at 9am – 4pm, so off we went in two cars to what was a huge market. A lot of tat, but a few bargains were had. By 11.30am, we had seen everything, so decided to return back to the van, drop off our purchases, and head into Stratford upon Avon, to fill up the cars ready for the Sunday journey back home, and see the sights of Stratford. Where was Tesco's? We were given directions and finally found a very busy Tesco garage forecourt. We filled up the car tanks, went into Tesco's, where John resisted the temptation to buy Michael flowers as they were too cheap!

Off into town following John for parking, never again! We lost John in traffic, so parked just off the ring road by the Holliday Inn. Seeing where John had parked, we headed into town, but John, Mike and Wayne were nowhere to be found, not even the town wardens had seen three camp queens appearing to be lost, but a telephone call to Eddie, and a follow up call from Wayne, and we were all reunited again. Off we then went into Stratford, found a small cafe with nice waiters, and had lunch. We then after lunch, went down to the river, before heading back to Charlecote near the site, to visit the garden centre, as Mike had seen a plant in Stratford he would like for the back of his ponds in the garden.
